Demand from China is fueling a secular bull market for commodities and Chinese investment in the resource industry and equity markets is an increasingly important factor in the world's economy. MercenaryGeologist.asia will extend our reach into this key segment of the financial and investment community.

In late April of 2008 we launched **The Mercenary Geologist** website and newsletter as the equities markets entered a worldwide economic crisis. As a contrarian investor and a strong proponent of the bull market in commodities, I foresaw an opportunity during the stock market meltdown for speculation in the junior resource sector.

I think all information on the internet should be free and so our business model is to offer a free email subscription to investors. In retrospect, the start-up of my newsletter in 2008 happened at an ideal time for investing. From September 2008 to the end of 2010, I picked 17 exploration and mining stocks at or near their 12-month lows. Fifteen of those stocks doubled in share price in 12 months or less, one tripled in 13 months, and only one of the seventeen was a failure. Considering the weakness in the junior resource market over the last nine months, I again foresee an opportunity for profitable speculation. With money to be made in the near- to mid-term, I will continue to present new ideas and companies to my loyal subscribers in the coming months.

Simply put, investing in stocks listed on the Toronto Venture Exchange is gambling. My investing philosophy applies conservative trading methods to the high risk/high reward nature of the junior resource sector. The trading methodology demands careful research and due diligence, but my track record proves

it is an effective way to skew the gambling odds in your favor. For a summary of my program, I urge you to read a musing called "[The Power of Two](#)".

In addition to informing subscribers of my investment in companies, **The Mercenary Geologist** newsletter addresses macroeconomic issues, geopolitics, commodity supply and demand fundamentals, and specific factors influencing the junior resource markets. Other pertinent topics include discussions on how to evaluate companies and consistently pick winners as a lay investor.

As an exploration and mining analyst, I travel to many countries for field evaluation of projects, speak personally with company management, and consult with an industry-wide network of investment professionals. In addition, I am an invited speaker at 15 investment conferences and events per year, and produce regular radio, print, and business television interviews.
